

#### 2025 #GoHealth Careers Expo – Student Terms and Conditions & Participation Waiver

#### **Event Overview**

The 2025 #GoHealth Careers Expo is an interactive event designed to inspire and inform students about career pathways in the health sector. The Expo will include a range of hands-on activities, demonstrations, and career exhibits. By attending, students agree to the following Terms and Conditions.

## 1. Participation in Activities

Students may have the opportunity to participate in hands-on health-related activities during the Expo. These may include (but are not limited to):

- Performing CPR on training mannequins
- Taking and recording vital signs (e.g. blood pressure, pulse)
- Touring emergency vehicles or mobile health units
- Engaging with simulation-based or role-play activities

**Important:** All activities will be supervised by qualified personnel and follow appropriate safety protocols. Participation is voluntary.

### 2. Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability

By attending the Expo, students (and their parent/guardian, if under 18) acknowledge that:

- They voluntarily assume all risks associated with participating in Expo activities;
- They waive any claims of liability against the Expo organisers (including but not limited to CheckUP, participating exhibitors, venue staff, and volunteers) for any injury or loss sustained during participation, except where caused by proven negligence.

#### 3. Photography and Videography

Photography and videography will take place throughout the Expo for promotional and educational purposes. This may include:

- Photos/videos taken by CheckUP staff or media partners
- Social media content or future promotional material for the #GoHealth Careers Expo

### **Opt-Out Process:**

Students who **do not** wish to appear in any photos or video must:

- Inform their teacher prior to attending the Expo;
- Be identified by the attending teacher at the registration desk on arrival.



These students will be issued with a different-coloured wristband to indicate their opt-out status to Expo photographers.

# 5. Code of Conduct

Students are expected to:

- Follow the directions of Expo staff, volunteers, and exhibitors at all times
- Treat all equipment and demonstrations with care and respect
- Maintain appropriate behaviour while participating in Expo activities and while moving around the venue

Inappropriate behaviour may result in removal from the Expo at the discretion of staff.

By attending the 2025 #GoHealth Careers Expo, the student and their parent/guardian (if under 18) acknowledge and accept these Terms and Conditions and grant consent to participate in all Expo activities, unless otherwise stated.
